ARRANGEMENT OF SECTIONS

SECTION

1. Short title.
2. Alteration of the Constitution.

AN ACT to alter the Constitution in accordance with Articles 66 and 164.

A.D. 2009

Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:-

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Constitution (Amendment) Act 2009.

Alteration of the  
Constitution.

2. The Constitution is altered by inserting immediately after Article 119C the following as Article 119D —

“Parliamentary  
Oversight  
Committee on the  
Security Sector.

119D. (1) There shall be a Standing Committee of the National Assembly to be named the Parliamentary Oversight Committee on the Security Sector and it shall have responsibility for examining the policies and administration of the entities in the security sector, namely, the Disciplined Forces of Guyana.

(2) To assist it in its work, the Committee shall have the power to co-opt experts or enlist the aid of other persons of appropriate expertise, whether or not such experts or persons are members of the National Assembly.”
