Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:-

Short title.
Cap. 91:04

1. This Act, which amends the Shops (Consolidation) Act, may be cited as the Shops (Consolidation) (Amendment) Act 2009.

2. Section 2 of the Principal Act is amended –

Cap. 82:22

(a) by the substitution, in paragraph (a) of the definition of "shop", for the word "premises", of the words "licensed premises as defined in section 2 of the Licensed Premises Act";

(b) by the insertion, after the words "delivery of goods" occurring at the end of the definition of "shop assistant", of the words "but does not include any worker as defined in section 2 of the Labour (Conditions of Employment of Certain Workers) Act 1978".

3. Section 8 of the Principal Act is amended by the deletion, in subsection (1), of the words "Parts 1 and 2 of".

Amendment of
section 12 of the
Principal Act.

4. Section 12 of the Principal Act is amended by the substitution, for the words "Parts 1 and 2 of the First Schedule and of", of the words "The First Schedule and".

Repeal and re-
enactment of the
First Schedule to
the Principal Act.

5. The First Schedule to the Principal Act is repealed and re-enacted by the following Schedule –

"FIRST SCHEDULE .sec.3**DAYS AND HOURS BETWEEN WHICH CERTAIN
SHOPS MAY BE KEPT OPEN**

The days on which and the hours between which shops, restaurants, parlours, cookshops, barbers' and hairdressers' establishments may be opened and kept open shall be as follows –

1. SHOPS

Every day - 7.30 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.

2. RESTAURANTS AND COOKSHOPS

24 hours per day.

3. PARLOURS, BARBERS' AND HAIRDRESSERS' ESTABLISHMENTS

Every day - 6.00 a.m. to midnight."
