AN ACT to amend the Bakeries (Hours of Work) Act.

A.D. 1994 Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:—

Short title.
Cap. 99:07

1. This Act, which amends the Bakeries (Hours of Work) Act, may be cited as the Bakeries (Hours of Work) (Amendment) Act 1994.

2. Section 3 of the Principal Act is hereby amended by the deletion of paragraph (b).

3. Section 5 of the Principal Act is hereby amended by the substitution for the words "between the hour of seven in the evening of any day and the hour of five in the morning of the following day for any period not exceeding two weeks", of the words "on any Sunday".

4. Section 6 (2) of the Principal Act is hereby amended by the substitution for the words "five hundred dollars", of the words "thirty-one thousand, two hundred and fifty dollars".

5. Section 9 of the Principal Act is hereby amended in the following manner —

- (a) in subsection (1), by the substitution for the words "two hundred dollars", of the words "twelve thousand, five hundred dollars"; and
- (b) in subsections (2) and (3), by the substitution for the words "five hundred dollars" wherever they occur, of the words "thirty-one thousand, two hundred and fifty dollars".
