ARRANGEMENT OF SECTIONS

SECTION

1. Short title.
2. Amendment of section 27 of the Principal Act.

AN ACT to amend the Interpretation and General Clauses Act.

A.D. 1986 Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:—

Short title. 1. This Act, which amends the Interpretation and General Clauses Act, may be cited as the Interpretation and General Clauses (Amendment) Act 1986.
Cap. 2:01

Amendment of section 27 of the Principal Act.

2. Section 27 of the Principal Act is hereby amended in the following respects —

(a) in subsection (3), by the substitution for the word “Nothing”, of the words “Subject to the provisions of subsection (3A), nothing”;

(b) by the insertion, after subsection (3), of the following subsection as subsection (3A) —

“(3A) The President may delegate a Minister or a Parliamentary Secretary to make subsidiary legislation or to hear any appeal on his behalf.”;

(c) by the substitution, in subsection (4) for the words “or a Minister” of the words⁴, a Minister or a Parliamentary Secretary”.
