AN ACT to amend the Registration of Births and Deaths $\mbox{\bf Act.}$

A.D. 1990 Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana:-

Short title and commencement. This Act, which amends the Registration of Births and Deaths Act, may be cited as the Registration Cap. 44:01 of Births and Deaths (Amendment) Act 1990 and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st July, 1987.
