AN ACT to amend the Coconut Products (Control) Act, the Tax Act, the Miscellaneous Licences Act, the Income Tax Act, the Estate Duty Act, the Hucksters Licensing and Control Act and the Auctioneers Act.

A.D. 1989 Enacted by the Parliament of Guyana :-

**Short title.** 1. This Act may be cited as the Fiscal Enactments (Amendment) (No. 2) Act 1989.

**Amendments of certain fiscal enactments.** 2. The enactments specified in the first column of the Schedule are hereby amended in the manner specified in the corresponding entry in the second column of that Schedule.
